Our Cape Wheel is a giant observation wheel that offers a spectacular 360° panoramic view of Cape Town from the vibrant V&A Waterfront precinct.

Your viewing experience across the Mother City includes Table Mountain, Robben Island, Cape Town City skyline, Paarl Mountains, and the Cape Town Stadium. The Cape Wheel offers 30 fully enclosed air conditioned cabins that will take you 40 metres above the ground in safety and comfort on the 12 – 15 minute, 4 revolution ride. Two of the cabins are wheelchair friendly.

- 1 The Cape Wheel**
This giant observation wheel lifts you 40m above the vibrant V&A Waterfront offering the most spectacular views of Cape Town from Table Mountain to Robben Island and everything in between.
- 2 The Cape Winelands**
A short drive from Cape Town delivers you into the legendary winelands of Stellenbosch, Paarl and Franschhoek where you will find some of the Cape's finest vineyards offering wine tastings and delectable meals.
- 3 Cape Town City Centre**
Explore our mother city on foot, buzzing with creativity and full of lively restaurants & bars. It's no wonder it was chosen as the World Design Capital for 2014.
- 4 The Company Gardens**
Have a break from the city life and enjoy a stroll through these tranquil gardens in the heart of Cape Town. Here you will also find the South African Museum, Planetarium, National Gallery, Jewish Museum and Parliament.
- 5 Woodstock**
In this historically multi-racial area grunge meets trendy in a colourful mix of rundown and renovated. A hive of creative spaces, quirky shops, delectable eateries and busy markets thrive here.
- 6 Kirstenbosch National Botanical Gardens**
The famously grand gardens located on the eastern slope of Table Mountain is the perfect place to picnic, surrounded by the indigenous flora of the Cape. Some of the best hikes also begin here.
- 7 Boulder's Beach**
This sheltered beach is a protected natural environment for the African Penguins. You can stroll the boardwalks and get really close.

- 8 Table Mountain**
One of the official New 7 Wonders of Nature and Cape Town's most iconic landmark. So many ways to enjoy the epic views: hike up one of the many routes, climb the face, abseil from the top or take a ride in the cable car.
- 9 Camps Bay**
Cape Town's picturesque white sandy beach strip, lined with palm trees, trendy bars and restaurants attract a large crowd in the summer months.
- 10 Lion's Head**
A popular hiking route to view the city and surrounds winds it's way up the slopes of Lion's Head. The mornings are breathtaking if you get up early enough to see the sunrise.
- 11 Noon Gun on Signal Hill**
Every day at 12pm since 1902 (except for Sundays and public holidays), a distinctive boom rings out over the city as a two ton cannon fires from the slopes of Signal Hill. Visitors are welcome to observe this daily ritual.
- 12 Sea Point**
This bustling, cosmopolitan suburb that never sleeps has something for everyone. Pubs, clubs, coffee shops and restaurants spread out along the Main Road ranging from laid back to upmarket and the pristine promenade alongside the sea has a traffic free stretch along which to stroll or jog.
- 13 Green Point Urban Park**
A free public park open from 7am to 7pm daily offers picnic space, outdoor gym facilities and a biodiversity garden with water features.
- 14 Cape Town Stadium**
Built for the 2010 FIFA World Cup™ and now a grand venue for international soccer matches, concerts and movie locations.
- 15 Green Point Light House**
A bold, candy striped landmark in the suburb of Mouille Point surrounded by open green lawns and a promenade running along the sea front. Visitors can take a self-guided tour inside the lighthouse tower.

- 16 The V&A Waterfront**
Situated in the heart of Cape Town's working harbour. Exciting indoor shopping and entertainment merges with outdoor ocean vistas, sea breezes and mountain views. Also home to the Cape Wheel.
- 17 The Two Oceans Aquarium**
Showcasing more than 3 000 marine creatures from the Atlantic and Indian Oceans. The aquarium is within walking distance from the Cape Wheel and offers full family entertainment.
- 18 The Clock Tower**
The charming icon of the old docks with museums to explore and souvenirs to purchase. Watch the Cape Fur Seals frolicking in the water or lazing about the quayside.
- 19 Robben Island**
Take a ferry from the Clock Tower to Robben Island and explore the prison where Nelson Mandela was kept captive along with the other political prisoners during the apartheid era.
